

### **Merricks Coolart Landcare Update**

There's been a whole lot happening out in the back paddocks recently. After a few delays due to lack of rain, Merricks Coolart Catchment Landcare Group kicked-off the winter planting season on the "Balnarring to the Bay" (Biolink 1) project here at Saltbush.

Over three different planting sessions, nearly 200 Landcare members and volunteers have gathered to rejuvenate the empty land that has been used for farming for years.

Spurred on by a shared vision, morning tea treats, and the promise of post-planting BBQ, the volunteers got to work at the first planting session in June. Planting a forest on this 7 acre paddock always looked daunting, but with a record number of highly motivated volunteers getting 1000 plants in the ground in under 3 hours, revegetating this massive paddock suddenly began to seem totally achievable.

After that first amazing day, an even bigger planting event happened over a full weekend in July. A big thank you to Mornington Peninsula Koala Conservation for partnering with Merricks Coolart Catchment Landcare group to make the weekend such a success. Together over the two days they planted a further 2100 trees and shrubs.

More than 7000 plants will be planted here this season, with another seven planting sessions planned with the community and schools. Stay tuned for the next planting session by following our social media.
